CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state parks; transferring the Hugo Lake Park to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department; authorizing Department to establish funds and accounts for the servicing of fiscal operations of the state park; exempting the Department from certain tort claims arising or accruing prior to certain date; providing for promulgation of rules for the transfer; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2229.1C of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       A. By January 1, 2025, all properties held in fee title, lease  
2 or otherwise, including interests in land, real estate options, or  
3 real estate contracts designated for Hugo Lake Park are hereby  
4 transferred to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.

5       B. Appropriate conveyances and other documents shall be  
6 executed by January 1, 2025, to effectuate the transfer of Hugo Lake  
7 Park.

8       C. The Department shall establish appropriate funds and  
9 accounts, including a revolving fund in the Office of Management and  
10 Enterprise Services, for servicing the fiscal operations of the  
11 park. Such funds and accounts shall be subject to the direct  
12 supervision, management, and control of the Department.

13       D. The Department shall not be responsible for any claims  
14 arising under The Governmental Tort Claims Act accrued prior to  
15 January 1, 2025, claims arising from any other actions accrued prior  
16 to January 1, 2025, or tort claims arising prior to January 1, 2025,  
17 for which no claim has accrued upon the date of transfer. The  
18 Department shall not be responsible for any claims arising out of  
19 construction begun before January 1, 2025, at Hugo Lake Park.

20       E. The Department shall promulgate the rules necessary for the  
21 transfer of property from Hugo Lake Park to the Oklahoma state park  
22 system.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
