**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1858 would authorize the state to display, in its buildings and on its grounds, replicas of historical documents. Additionally, the measure would direct the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to determine the design, placement, security, and construction of a monument of the Ten commandments outside and inside the Oklahoma State Capitol. Only donated funds shall be used for the design, placement, security, and construction of the monuments. There is no fiscal impact to the state.
