A streamlined provider enrollment and credentialing process 10 for any Medicaid fee-for-service delivery system; and 11 2. A single consolidated provider enrollment and credentialing 12 process for a managed care delivery system in accordance with 13 subsection D of Section 4002.4 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes 14 and 42 C.F.R., Section 438.214. 15 SECTION 2.
