12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2021, Section 2251, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 2251. In the event of a formal declaration of emergency
15	drought conditions by the Governor, the Emergency Drought Commission
16	shall be formed consisting of the Executive Director of the Oklahoma
17	Conservation Commission, the Secretary of Agriculture and, the
18	Executive Director of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, one member
19	appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
20	and one member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
21	Oklahoma State Senate. The Emergency Drought Commission shall
22	determine the expenditures to be made from the Emergency Drought
23	Relief Fund created in Section 1 of this act, subject to approval by
24	the Governor and shall determine the appropriate agency to expend

the funds. The Emergency Drought Commission shall also serve as a

    drought advisory panel to the Governor and the various state

    agencies. The activities of the Emergency Drought Commission shall

    continue until it is determined by the Governor that a drought

        SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
 7
    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
 8
    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
 9
    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
