13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1111 of Title 60, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	The state shall limit the amount of public land owned by the
18	State of Oklahoma, state agencies, and federal government to no more
19	than twelve percent (12%) of the total land in the state.
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1112 of Title 60, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. All easements granted to or reserved by the federal
24	government, on or after the effective date of this act, for land

<sup>2</sup> (30) years or less.

B. All easements granted to or reserved by the State of Oklahoma or state agencies shall be for a period of thirty (30) years or less. Any easements held by the State of Oklahoma or any state agency that has been owned by the state or any state agency for longer than thirty (30) years are hereby released and relinquished. SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024. 59-2-9120 JL 12/14/23 \_ .
