HOUSE BILL 3264

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public finance; requiring state governmental entities to submit budget related information; specifying deadline for submission; requiring submission of information to chairs and vice-chairs of designated committees of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.401 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each agency, board, commission, department or other state governmental entity that received any funds from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury pursuant to an appropriation measure during the fiscal year ending June 30 of any applicable year and each agency, board, commission, department or other state governmental entity deriving its funding from a revolving fund, a statutorily created fund, fees imposed or authorized pursuant to

1 state law or other public revenue sources shall submit a complete
2 budget request, including any request for an increase in funding,
3 whether through appropriations or otherwise, not later than the
4 first day of the regular session of each year of the legislative
5 biennium. The budget document shall be submitted to the chair and
6 vice-chair of the Appropriation and Budget Committee of the Oklahoma
7 House of Representatives and to the chair and vice-chair of the
8 Senate Appropriations committee or to any successor committees of
9 either chamber primarily responsible for consideration of state
10 agency appropriations.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
