7	An Act relating to school class sizes; requiring
8	payment of a stipend for teachers with classes that fail to comply with class size limitations;
9	establishing stipend amounts based on years of teaching experience and certain certification;
10	providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-113.6 of Title 70, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year and each school
19	year thereafter, a school district shall pay a stipend as provided
20	in subsection B of this section to certain teachers who are
21	responsible for the instruction of a class that fails to comply with
22	the class size limitations required in subsections A and B of
23	Section 18-113.1, subsection A of Section 18-113.2, and subsection C
24	of Section 18-113.3 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. The stipends required by subsection A of this section shall be paid as follows:

I. If the teacher has a least five (5) years of classroom teaching experience or possesses National Board certification, the stipend shall be Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for each additional student in excess of the class size limitations established in subsections A and B of Section 18-113.1 or subsection A of Section 18-113.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 2. If the teacher has least five (5) years of classroom
10 teaching experience or possesses National Board certification, the
11 stipend shall be Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each additional
12 student in excess of the class size limitation established in
13 subsection C of Section 18-113.3 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
14 Statutes; and

¹⁵ 3. If the teacher has at least ten (10) years of classroom ¹⁶ teaching experience and possesses National Board certification, the ¹⁷ stipend amounts in paragraphs 1 and 2 of this subsection shall be ¹⁸ increased by twenty percent (20%).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
