6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school safety; prohibiting false
8 personation of a student; prescribing punishment upon
9 conviction; prohibiting trespass on school premises
10 after false personation; providing for penalties upon
conviction; defining term; providing for
11 codification; providing an effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-131.3 of Title 70, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Any person who knowingly and falsely personates a student of
18 a public school with the intent to trespass on the premises at that
19 school, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall
20 be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars
21 (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than
22 ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

23 B. Any person who trespasses on school premises after knowingly
24 and falsely personating a student at that school, shall be guilty of
--

1 a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of
2 not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in
3 the county jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such
4 fine and imprisonment.

5 C. As used in this section, "premises" means the real property
6 on which a public school is located including, but not limited to,
7 school buildings, grounds, athletic fields, gymnasiums, auditoriums,
8 and parking lots owned or leased for use by the school.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
