A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 238 of Title 44, unless there is 17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Defense 19 Workforce Grant Program". 20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 239 of Title 44, unless there is 22 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 23 There is hereby created the Defense Workforce Grant Program 24

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which shall be administered by the Oklahoma Military Department.

The Program shall increase the workforce in Oklahoma, specifically the workforce dedicated to federal defense contract work. program shall help provide gap financing to companies actively working with the United States Department of Defense or any United States Military Branch to expand current contracts or secure new contracts for new work. The Program shall not be used for renewal of contracts with the United States Department of Defense or any United States Military Branch. The location of the work to be provided shall be in a county of the state with a population of less than seventy-five thousand (75,000) people per the 2020 Federal The applying company shall have available other Decennial Census. sources of funding dedicated to helping finance the new project or the expansion of an existing project. Beginning July 1, 2025, the Oklahoma Military Department shall provide an annual report to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the State Senate that includes, but is not limited to, the number of awards that have been granted, what percentage of those funds that have been expended, and the increased number of employees that have been hired by awardees. A new section of law to be codified SECTION 3. NEW LAW

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in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 240 of Title 44, unless there is

created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 2 for the Oklahoma Military Department to be designated the "Defense 3 Workforce Grant Program Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a 4 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 5 consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Military Department 6 from appropriations, donations, grants, or other sources of funding 7 specifically designated for deposit to the Defense Workforce Grant 8 Program Revolving Fund. All monies accruing to the credit of said 9 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the 10 Military Department for the purpose of the Defense Workforce Grant 11 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants 12 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by 13 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 14 Services for approval and payment. The Military Department may 15 retain one percent (1%) of all funds otherwise deposited to the fund 16 to cover administrative costs related to the Defense Workforce Grant 17 Program.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
