HOUSE BILL 3803

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to memorial roads and bridges;  
designating the James L. Holt, Pres. of the Seminole  
Tribe of Florida Memorial Bridge; requiring markers  
be placed; providing for codification; and providing  
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.431 of Title 69, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge crossing over Panther Creek on U.S. Highway 64 in  
Pawnee County shall be designated as the "James L. Holt, Pres. of  
the Seminole Tribe of Florida Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
