6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; creating the Felony
8 Voting Rights Notification Act; requiring
9 notification process of restoration of voting rights
10 for individuals convicted of a felony; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-101.1 of Title 26, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Felony
17 Voting Rights Notification Act".

18 B. The purpose of this act is to establish a collaboration
19 between the State Election Board and the Department of Corrections
20 to notify individuals convicted of a felony when their voting rights
21 have been restored.

22 C. The State Election Board and the Department of Corrections
23 shall collaborate to establish a notification system. The
24 notification shall include information about the restoration of the
--

1 voting rights of the individual and relevant procedures for the
2 individual to apply for voter registration.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
