AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commemorating the 78th Southern  
Legislative Conference of the Council of State  
Governments Southern Office.

WHEREAS, the Council of State Governments Southern Office  
(CSG South) is a nonpartisan, nonprofit member organization that  
serves the southern legislatures of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida,  
Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North  
Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia,  
and West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, with regionally based state leadership and  
perspective, and national-level resources, CSG South provides  
southern legislators and government staff with a wide variety of  
programs and services that facilitate regional cooperation and  
encourage the exchange of information; and

WHEREAS, in pursuit of this mission, CSG South has convened  
the Southern Legislative Conference (SLC) for the past 77 years,  
with decades of fellowship and cooperation between the Southern
