SENATE BILL 1033

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; creating the Parent, Community, and School Board Accessibility Act; providing short title; requiring public school districts to post on their websites certain information about board of education members, the school district superintendent, and board of education elections; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-107C of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Parent, Community, and School Board Accessibility Act".

B. Each public school district in this state shall post within one click of the home page of the school district's website the following information:

1. The name, picture, email address, phone number, mailing address, and a short biography for each member of the school

1 district's board of education. The biography shall include the date
2 the member was elected to office and the date his or her term of
3 office expires;

4 2. The name, picture, email address, phone number, mailing
5 address, and a short biography for the school district
6 superintendent; and

7 3. The date of the next election for school district board of
8 education members, information on how to become a candidate, and a
9 map of each board district within the school district.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
