SENATE BILL 111

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; prohibiting institutions of higher education from accepting certain funds; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3251 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall accept funds from an individual or entity that is or has been associated with the China-based People's Liberation Army.

B. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
