SENATE BILL 1274

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to health insurance; defining terms; requiring coverage of certain examination under certain circumstances; subjecting certain coverage to certain annual limits; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.8b of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this section:

1. "Health benefit plan" means a plan as defined pursuant to Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

2. "Positron emission tomography" or "PET scan" means an imaging test that uses radioactive substances to visualize and measure metabolic processes in the body to help reveal how tissues and organs are functioning.

B. Any health benefit plan, including the Oklahoma Employees Insurance Plan, that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state on

1 or after the effective date of this act shall provide coverage for  
2 positron emission tomography as a first-step screening for any  
3 cancer patient who is in remission.

4 C. The coverage provided under this section shall be subject to  
5 the same annual deductibles, co-payments, or coinsurance limits as  
6 established for other covered benefits under the health plan.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
