An Act relating to uniform tax procedure; amending 68 O.S. 2021, Section 255.2, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 113, O.S.L. 2023 (68 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 255.2), which relates to enforcement of tax on medical marijuana; requiring assessment, collection, and enforcement of certain tax; eliminating collection fee; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 255.2, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 113, O.S.L. 2023 (68 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 255.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 255.2. As provided in Section 426 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority and the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall enter into a contract whereby the Tax Commission shall have authority to assess, collect, and enforce the seven percent (7%) tax on retail medical marijuana sales and any penalties and interest thereon. Such assessment, collection, and enforcement authority shall apply to any tax and any penalty or interest liability on retail medical marijuana sales existing at the

time of contracting. The contract shall provide for the assessment, collection, and enforcement of the tax on retail medical marijuana sales in the same manner as the administration, collection, and enforcement of any tax payable by any taxpayer subject to taxation under any state tax law. For providing such collection assistance, the Tax Commission shall charge the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority a fee of one and five-tenths percent (1.5%) of the gross collection proceeds. All funds retained by the Tax Commission for the collection services shall be deposited in the Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund in the State Treasury.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
