7	An Act relating to professions and occupations; requiring certain licensing boards to utilize certain
8	web-based platform for application and renewal of professional licenses; requiring Service Oklahoma to

10	construction; authorizing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6021.1 of Title 59, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. All licensing boards of this state providing licensing for
19	professional occupations including, but not limited to, the
20	following shall utilize the web-based platform described in
21	subsection B of this section for application and renewal of
22	professional licenses:
23	1. The Oklahoma Accountancy Board;

1	2. The Board of Governors of the Licensed Architects, Landscape
2	Architects and Registered Commercial Interior Designers of Oklahoma;
3	3. The State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering;
4	4. The Oklahoma Funeral Board;
5	5. The State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and
6	Land Surveyors;
7	6. The State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners;
8	7. The Oklahoma Real Estate Commission;
9	8. The Real Estate Appraiser Board;
10	9. The Construction Industries Board;
11	10. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission;
12	11. The Oklahoma Inspector Examiners Committee; and
13	12. The Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Committee.
14	B. Service Oklahoma shall select the singular web-based
15	platform for licensing of professional occupations in accordance
16	with the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act and shall host the platform
17	on its website.
18	C. Service Oklahoma and all licensing boards of this state
19	providing licensing for professional occupations including, but not
20	limited to, those listed in subsection A of this section shall enter
21	into interagency agreements to implement the provisions of this
22	section.
23	D. Nothing in this section shall be construed to:

Remove, abrogate, reduce, or otherwise affect any power or 2 duty of a licensing board to establish or enforce licensure 3 qualifications, examination requirements, or disciplinary standards 4 or procedures, or to exercise any other power or duty of the 5 licensing board provided by law; or 6 2. Confer to Service Oklahoma any power or duty of a licensing 7 board provided by law including, but not limited to, those described 8 in paragraph 1 of this subsection. The sole function of Service 9 Oklahoma under this section shall be to select and host the web-10 based platform as provided by subsection B of this section. 11 The Executive Director of Service Oklahoma and all licensing Ε. 12 boards covered under this section may promulgate rules as necessary 13 to implement the provisions of this section. 14 SECTION 2.
