SENATE BILL 1582

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to health benefits; defining term; establishing maximum copayment for certain health benefit plans; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6057.6 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. For the purposes of this section, "health benefit plan" means a health benefit plan as defined pursuant to Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Any health benefit plan, including the Oklahoma Employees Insurance Plan, that is offered, issued, or renewed on or after the effective date of this act shall not require a copayment for prescription drugs that exceeds one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual out-of-pocket spending maximum. Enrollees in a high deductible health plan shall meet the annual deductible for the plan before the copayment limit in this subsection may apply.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2025.

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
