6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to county elective offices; amending
8 26 O.S. 2021, Section 12-111, which relates to
9 vacancies in county elective offices; prohibiting
10 special election for certain vacancies; updating
11 statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 12-111, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 12-111. A. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in the
16 office of a county commissioner, the vacancy shall be filled at a
17 special election to be called by the Governor within thirty (30)
18 days after the vacancy occurs. Provided, no special election shall
19 be called if the vacancy occurs in an even-numbered year if ~~the term~~
20 ~~of the office expires~~ is scheduled to appear on the ballot the same
21 year, or if the vacancy occurs on or after December 1 of an odd-
22 numbered year if the office is scheduled to appear on the ballot the
23 following year. In such case, the candidate elected to the office
24 at the Primary Election, runoff Primary Election, or the regular

1 General Election shall be appointed by the Governor as soon as
2 practical after the applicable election to fill the unexpired term.

3 B. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in any elective county office
4 of any county in this state having a population of more than the
5 population figure specified in subsection ~~B~~ E of Section 10 of Title
6 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the vacancy shall be filled at a
7 special election to be called by the Governor within thirty (30)
8 days after the vacancy occurs. Provided, no special election shall
9 be called if the vacancy occurs in an even-numbered year if ~~the term~~
10 of the office expires is scheduled to appear on the ballot the same
11 year, or if the vacancy occurs on or after December 1 of an odd-
12 numbered year if the office is scheduled to appear on the ballot the
13 following year. In such case, the candidate elected to the office
14 at the Primary Election, runoff Primary Election, or the regular
15 General Election shall be appointed by the Governor as soon as
16 practical after the applicable election to fill the unexpired term.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
