12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1354, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1354. There is hereby re-created, to continue until
16	July 1, 2023 July 1, 2025, pursuant to the provisions of the
17	Oklahoma Sunset Law, the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists.
18	The Board shall administer the provisions of the Psychologists
19	Licensing Act. The Board shall consist of seven (7) members
20	appointed by the Governor. Five members shall be psychologists from
21	various areas in psychology and two members shall be lay persons.
22	At the expiration of the term of each Board member who is a
23	psychologist, the Governor shall appoint a successor from a list of
24	ten licensed psychologists which is provided by the Oklahoma State

1 Psychological Association. Members shall serve for a term of four 2 (4) years and until a successor is appointed and qualified. Before 3 entering upon the duties of office, each member of the Board shall 4 take the constitutional oath of office and file it with the 5 Secretary of State. 6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023. 7 SECTION 3.
