SENATE BILL 1690

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to internal combustion engines;
prohibiting certain future action; declaring
protection of certain rights for individuals in
Oklahoma; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3001 of Title 25, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The use of internal combustion engines including, but not
limited to, technology, equipment, mechanical systems, or
transportation and gas-fueled stoves, shall not be prohibited by
this state or any political subdivision of this state. The rights
of individuals in Oklahoma to use internal combustion engines and
gas-fueled stoves shall be protected in this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
