12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-406.2 of Title 43A, unless
14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	To the extent allowed under federal law, and subject to any
16	necessary federal approval, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, the
17	Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, or a
18	contracted entity as defined in Section 4002.2 of Title 56 of the
19	Oklahoma Statutes shall not reimburse services provided by certified
20	alcohol and drug counselors at a lower rate than would be reimbursed
21	the same service provided by a licensed alcohol and drug counselor.

23	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
