AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1431, is 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 1431. Every person who breaks into and enters the 18 dwelling house of another, or who enters into a restricted area of a 19 commercial building without authorization, in which there is at the 20 time some human being, with intent to commit some crime therein, 21 either by: 22 1. By forcibly Forcibly bursting or breaking the wall, or an 23 outer door, window, or shutter of a window of such house or the lock 24

or bolts of such door, or the fastening of such window or shutter;  $\frac{\partial}{\partial r}$ 

- 2. Forcibly bursting or breaking the wall, or an outer door, window, or shutter of a window, of such commercial building or by entering an area of a business not ordinarily open to the public without permission;
- 3. By breaking Breaking in any other manner, being armed with a dangerous weapon or being assisted or aided by one or more confederates then actually present; or

## 3. By unlocking

- 4. Unlocking an outer door by means of false keys or by picking the lock thereof, or by lifting a latch or opening a window, is quilty of burglary in the first degree.
- SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1435, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 245, O.S.L. 2022 (21 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 1435), is amended to read as follows:
- Section 1435. A. Every person who breaks and enters the dwelling house of another, in which there is at the time no human being present, or any commercial building or any part of any building, room, booth, tent, railroad car, or other structure or erection in which any property is kept or who enters into a restricted area of a commercial building without authorization or breaks into or forcibly opens, any coin-operated or vending machine

or device with intent to steal any property therein or to commit any felony, is guilty of burglary in the second degree. B. Every person who breaks and enters, climbs under, or uses any jack stands or any other item to raise any automobile, truck, trailer or vessel of another, in which any property is kept, with intent to: 1. Steal any property therein; 2. Steal any property attached thereto; or 3. Commit any felony, is guilty of burglary in the third degree. C. As used in subsection B of this section, the term "property attached thereto" includes, but is not limited to, tires, wheels, and catalytic converters. SECTION 3.
