20	information as to the make, year, serial number, license tag with
21	year and the state from which the tag was issued.
22	$\frac{\text{(c)}}{3.}$ A full statement of all the facts.
23	$\frac{\text{(d)}}{\text{4.}}$ The amount of the claim, giving a full description of
24	the work, labor, storage or any other costs involved.
