Except as provided in Section 815 of this title, 17 no person shall hold an interest in a domestic professional entity 18 including a domestic professional entity that owns a domestic 19 professional entity rendering professional service, who is not duly 20 licensed or otherwise permitted in accordance with the provisions of 21 this state's licensing laws for the profession or related profession 22 to render the same professional services or related professional 23 services as those for which the entity is organized. be a shareholder of a professional corporation who is not an

3	which the corporation is organized. An owner of a qualified foreign
4	professional entity shall not be required to be duly licensed if he

6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
