"Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as 2 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the 3 Oklahoma Statutes. 4 B. Any health benefit plan, including the Oklahoma Employees 5 Insurance Plan, that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state on 6 or after the effective date of this act shall provide coverage for 7 home health care for a developmentally disabled person whose care 8 requires supervision of a licensed health professional. 9 coverage provided by this section shall be subject to the same 10 annual deductibles, copayments, or coinsurance limits as established 11 for all covered benefits under the health benefit plan. 12 SECTION 2.
