SENATE JOINT
RESOLUTION 10

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article XXII of the Oklahoma Constitution; prohibiting certain ownership of land through business entity or trust; decreasing allowable time period for disposition of certain property; modifying exception to certain ownership requirements; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1st SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article XXII of the Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

Section 1. No ~~alien or person who is not a~~ foreign citizen ~~of the United States,~~ shall acquire title to or own land in this state either directly or indirectly through a business entity or trust, and the Legislature shall enact laws whereby all persons ~~not~~ who are foreign citizens ~~of the United States,~~ and their heirs, who may

1 hereafter acquire real estate in this state by devise, descent, or
2 otherwise, shall dispose of the same within ~~five years~~ one (1) year
3 upon condition of escheat or forfeiture to the State: Provided,
4 This shall not apply to Indians born within the United States, nor
5 to aliens or persons not citizens of the United States who may
6 become bona fide residents of this State: ~~And Provided Further,~~
7 ~~That this section shall not apply to lands now owned by aliens in~~
8 ~~this State.~~

9 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
10 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
11 the following form:

13 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

14 This measure will amend Section 1 of Article 22 of the Oklahoma
15 Constitution. The measure will prohibit ownership of land in
16 Oklahoma by a foreign citizen or a business entity or trust
17 owned by foreign citizens. The measure will decrease to 1 year
18 the time period for such land to be returned to the state. The
19 measure provides an exception to lawful resident foreign
20 citizens.
