NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 301B of Title 44, unless there 19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving Α. 21 fund for the Oklahoma Military Department to be designated the "Base 22 Infrastructure Needs and Development - Schools Revolving Fund", 23

which may also be cited as "BIND - Schools Fund". The fund shall be

a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall

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- 1 | consist of all monies directed for deposit to the fund by law. All
- 2 | monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated

- 4 | for the purpose established in subsection B of this section.
