13 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause, and entire bill  
14 and insert:

16 "An Act relating to groundwater permits; amending 82  
17 O.S. 2021, Section 1020.7, which relates to  
18 groundwater permit applications; requiring certain  
19 license and registration be presented for persons  
intending to use groundwater for medical marijuana  
grow facilities; providing an effective date; and  
declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1020.7, is  
24 amended to read as follows:

1       Section 1020.7. Any person intending to use groundwater shall  
2 ~~make application~~ apply to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board for an  
3 appropriate permit as provided in Section 1020.11 of this title  
4 before commencing any drilling for such purposes and before taking  
5 water from any completed well heretofore drilled. Such application  
6 to take and use groundwater shall be on a form provided by the Board  
7 and pursuant to the rules and regulations established by the Board.  
8 Any person intending to use groundwater for a medical marijuana grow  
9 facility shall present to the Board a valid medical marijuana  
10 commercial grower license issued by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana  
11 Authority pursuant to Section 427.14 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma  
12 Statutes and an Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics Manufacturer  
13 Registration.

14       The application heretofore filed with the Board shall be used in  
15 granting permits for existing wells and the Board shall publish the  
16 notice of the hearing thereon.

17       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

18       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1020.7. Any person intending to use groundwater shall  
15 ~~make application~~ apply to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board for an  
16 appropriate permit as provided in Section 1020.11 of this title  
17 before commencing any drilling for such purposes and before taking  
18 water from any completed well heretofore drilled. Such application  
19 to take and use groundwater shall be on a form provided by the Board  
20 and pursuant to the rules and regulations established by the Board,  
21 and shall include documentation that the applicant has a valid,  
22 unexpired driver license issued in this state or a valid United  
23 States passport.

1 The application heretofore filed with the Board shall be used in  
2 granting permits for existing wells and the Board shall publish the  
3 notice of the hearing thereon.

4 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

5 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
