The Secretary of the State Election Board shall have the authority to direct the secretary of a county 8 9 election board to conduct a post-election audit of election results 10 for any election, for the purpose of maintaining the security of the 11 election system by ensuring that voting devices and software used in 12 a particular election correctly tabulated votes. The Secretary 13 shall direct the secretary of the county election board in each 14 county to conduct a post-election audit following elections held on 15 dates set forth in Sections 1-101, 1-102, 1-103, and 20-101 of this 16 title.

B. The method, timing, and procedures for conducting a postelection audit shall be determined by the Secretary of the State
Election Board.

C. The secretary of a county election board shall report the findings of a post-election audit to the Secretary of the State Election Board, and such report shall be available to the public.

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D. The Secretary of the State Election Board may promulgate policies, rules, and procedures to implement the requirements of this section.

E. For the purposes of this title, a "post-election audit" is 4 5 defined as means a manual or electronic examination of a limited number of ballots by a secretary of a county election board or other 6 7 authorized election officials following an election. A post-8 election audit shall be conducted only at the direction of the 9 Secretary of the State Election Board and only subject to the 10 Secretary's previously promulgated prescribed policies, rules, or 11 procedures.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025."
