21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 801.10 of Title 17, unless there
24 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 No rate-regulated retail electric supplier, as defined in
2 Section 158.22 of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall offer
3 ratepayer-funded incentives, rebates, or inducements to its
4 customers to promote the switching of fuel sources from natural gas
5 to electricity.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
