12 and references; and declaring an emergency.

13 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause, and entire bill  
14 and insert:  
15

16 "An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
17 21 O.S. 2021, Sections 1902 and 1903, which relate to  
18 the Bus Passenger Safety Act; modifying scope of  
19 certain definitions; adding definition; expanding  
20 scope of unlawful acts; updating statutory language  
21 and references; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1902, is  
24 amended to read as follows:

Section 1902. As used in the Bus Passenger Safety Act:

1        1. "Bus" means a vehicle designed to carry passengers that is  
2 part of a network of passenger vehicles for use by the public,  
3 running on a regular schedule of routes, times, and fares;

4        2. "Bus transportation company" or "company" means any person  
5 or governmental entity providing for-hire transport to passengers or  
6 cargo by ~~bus~~ rolling stock transit vehicles upon the roads, streets,  
7 highways, public or dedicated rights-of-way, and turnpikes of this  
8 state;

9        3. "Deadly or dangerous weapon" includes all weapons listed in  
10 Section 1287 of this title, and any other weapon capable of  
11 inflicting serious bodily injury, except for a weapon carried for  
12 lawful self-defense in compliance under the Oklahoma ~~Self-Defense~~  
13 Self-Defense Act;

14        4. "Passenger" means any person served by the bus  
15 transportation company; ~~and~~

16        5. "Rolling stock transit vehicles" include buses, vans, cars,  
17 railcars, locomotives, trolley cars, ferry boats, and vehicles used  
18 for transporting the public; and

19        6. "Terminal" means a bus station, stop, platform, or depot or  
20 any facility operated or leased by or operated on behalf of a bus  
21 transportation company. This term shall include a reasonable area  
22 immediately adjacent to any designated stop along the route traveled  
23 by any ~~bus~~ rolling stock transit vehicle operated by a bus  
24

1 transportation company and parking lots or parking areas adjacent to  
2 a terminal.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1903, is  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 1903. A. No person shall by force or violence, or  
6 threat of force or violence, seize or exercise control of any ~~bus~~  
7 rolling stock transit vehicle. Any person violating this subsection  
8 shall be guilty of a felony and shall, upon conviction, be punished  
9 by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for  
10 not more than twenty (20) years, or by a fine ~~of~~ not more than  
11 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and  
12 imprisonment.

13 B. ~~In addition, no~~ No person shall intimidate, threaten,  
14 assault, or batter any driver, attendant, guard, or passenger of any  
15 ~~bus with intent to violate subsection A of this section~~ rolling  
16 stock transit vehicle or cause disruption to the provided service or  
17 cause harm to any person. Any person violating this subsection  
18 shall be guilty of a felony and shall, upon conviction, be punished  
19 by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for  
20 not more than ten (10) years, ~~or~~ by a fine ~~of~~ not more than Five  
21 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

22 C. ~~In addition, any~~ Any person violating subsection A or B of  
23 this section using a dangerous or deadly weapon shall be guilty of a  
24 felony, and shall, upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment in

1 the custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than  
2 twenty (20) years, ~~or~~ by a fine ~~of~~ not more than Twenty Thousand  
3 Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

4 D. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm  
5 into or within any ~~bus~~ rolling stock transit vehicle, terminal, or  
6 other transportation facility, unless such action is determined to  
7 have been in defensive force resulting from reasonable fear of  
8 imminent peril of death or great bodily harm to himself or herself  
9 or another. Such person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a  
10 felony punishable by a fine ~~of~~ not more than Five Thousand Dollars  
11 (\$5,000.00) ~~or~~, by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of  
12 Corrections for not more than five (5) years, or by both such fine  
13 and imprisonment.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

13 by any ~~bus~~ rolling stock transit vehicle operated by a bus  
14 transportation company and parking lots or parking areas adjacent to  
15 a terminal; and

16 7. "Transit worker" means any employee, contractor, or  
17 volunteer working on behalf of a transit agency.

18 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1903, is  
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1903. A. No person shall by force or violence, or  
21 threat of force or violence, seize or exercise control of any ~~bus~~  
22 rolling stock transit vehicle. Any person violating this subsection  
23 shall be guilty of a felony and shall, upon conviction, be punished  
24 by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for

1 not more than twenty (20) years, or by a fine ~~of~~ not more than  
2 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and  
3 imprisonment.

4 B. ~~In addition, no~~ No person shall intimidate, threaten,  
5 assault, or batter any driver, attendant, guard, transit worker, or  
6 passenger of any ~~bus with intent to violate subsection A of this~~  
7 ~~section~~ rolling stock transit vehicle or cause disruption to the  
8 provided service or cause harm to any person. Any person violating  
9 this subsection shall be guilty of a felony and shall, upon  
10 conviction, be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the  
11 Department of Corrections for not more than ten (10) years, ~~or~~ by a  
12 fine ~~of~~ not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both  
13 such fine and imprisonment.

14 C. ~~In addition, any~~ Any person violating subsection A or B of  
15 this section using a dangerous or deadly weapon shall be guilty of a  
16 felony, and shall, upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment in  
17 the custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than  
18 twenty (20) years, ~~or~~ by a fine ~~of~~ not more than Twenty Thousand  
19 Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

20 D. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm  
21 into or within any ~~bus~~ rolling stock transit vehicle, terminal, or  
22 other transportation facility, unless such action is determined to  
23 have been in defensive force resulting from reasonable fear of  
24 imminent peril of death or great bodily harm to himself or herself



1 or another. Such person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a  
2 felony punishable by a fine ~~of~~ not more than Five Thousand Dollars  
3 (\$5,000.00) ~~or~~, by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of  
4 Corrections for not more than five (5) years, or by both such fine  
5 and imprisonment.

6 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
