9	An Act relating to counties and county officers;
10	directing county offices and courts to offer option to pay via credit card for all transactions;
11	permitting county offices and courts to pass on service fee; directing county offices and courts to
12	provide forms; prohibiting charging a fee for forms; directing that certain forms be made available on
13	county website; mandating county offices and courts have a notary during business hours; prohibiting
14	notaries from charging a fee; directing the Attorney General to standardize forms; directing counties to
15	implement forms by certain date; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 272 of Title 19, unless there is
21	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	All county offices and courts shall offer the option to pay via
23	credit card for all transactions except where provided in Section
24	3127 of Title 68 as it states that such real estate will be sold to

1 the highest bidder for cash. County offices and courts shall be 2 allowed to pass the service fee onto the person requesting to pay 3 via credit card.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 273 of Title 19, unless there is 6 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 All county offices, including courts, shall be responsible for providing any forms necessary to citizens of the county when 8 9 conducting business or legal proceedings with that county office or 10 court. County offices and courts may not charge a fee for providing 11 or printing such forms. County offices shall make all forms necessary for citizens of the county when conducting business or 12 13 legal proceedings with that county office or court available on the 14 county website.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 274 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Every county office, including the county clerk's office, 19 the county treasurer's office, the county assessor's office, and the 20 county courthouse, shall have a notary available during business 21 hours.

B. The notary may not charge a fee for their services.
