PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to medication; defining term; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to partner with the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center to provide medication to certain inmates; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to directly pay the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for medication for certain inmates; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7500 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this section, "medication" means prescription and over-the-counter drugs.

B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall partner with the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center to provide medication to detainees and inmates under the jurisdiction of a

1 municipality or county, and not under the jurisdiction of the
2 Department of Corrections.

3 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall directly pay to the
4 University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center for medication
5 provided to detainees and inmates under the jurisdiction of a
6 municipality or county, not under the jurisdiction of the Department
7 of Corrections.

8 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules to
9 implement this section of law.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
