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1 limitations provided in this section may be conditionally pre-2 qualified by the Department in subsequent fiscal years. The amount of rebate payments conditionally pre-qualified by 3 Β. 4 the Department of Commerce each fiscal year with respect to any of 5 the incentives authorized pursuant to this act shall not exceed: 6 Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000.00) 1. 7 for production projects with total expenditures of less than Seven 8 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000.00); and 9 2. Twenty-two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 10 (\$22,500,000.00) for production projects with total expenditures of 11 Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000.00) or more; 12 3. Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) for live studio 13 audience production projects; and 14 4. Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00) for a film project 15 with a budget of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or less. As 16 used in this paragraph, "film" shall have the same meaning as 17 prescribed by paragraph 6 of Section 3632 of this title. 18 C. A production project shall have total expenditures of Fifty 19 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or more to be eligible for the rebate 20 payments provided in this act. 21 D. In any fiscal year if the amount of rebate payments 22 conditionally pre-qualified by the Department of Commerce are less 23 than the limitations provided in this section, the excess rebate 24
