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SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to relocate a naval submarine located east of State Highway 165 and north of State Highway 62.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund created pursuant to Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes the sum of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement infrastructure improvements at an industrial park located south of State Highway 62 and east of State Highway 283.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

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SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
