8 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
10 amending 57 O.S. 2021, Section 504, which relates to
11 the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967; expanding
12 powers and duties of the State Board of Corrections;
13 and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2021, Section 504, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 504. ~~(a)~~ A. The Board shall elect from its members a
18 ~~chairman~~ chair, ~~vice chairman~~ vice-chair, and a secretary. ~~It~~ The
19 Board shall adopt rules and regulations for its government and may
20 adopt an official seal for the Department. Members shall be
21 reimbursed for travel expenses, as provided in the State Travel
22 Reimbursement Act, while attending meetings of the Board or while
23 performing other official duties.

1 ~~(b)~~ B. The Board shall have the following powers and
2 duties:

3 ~~(1)~~ 1. To establish policies for the operation of the
4 Department;

5 ~~(2)~~ 2. To establish and maintain such institutions as are
6 necessary or convenient for the operation of programs for the
7 education, training, vocational education, and rehabilitation of
8 prisoners under the jurisdiction of the Department;

9 ~~(3)~~ 3. To lease, from time to time, without restriction as to
10 terms, any property which said Board shall determine advisable to
11 more fully carry into effect the operation of prison industries;

12 ~~(4)~~ 4. To acquire, construct, extend, improve, maintain and
13 operate any and all facilities of all kinds which in the judgment of
14 the Board shall be necessary or convenient to foster the prison
15 industries program;

16 ~~(5)~~ 5. To require the Director and any other personnel of the
17 Department, when deemed necessary by the Board, to give bond for the
18 faithful performance of their duties;

19 ~~(6)~~ 6. To appoint and fix the salary of the Director;

20 ~~(7)~~ 7. To enter into contracts with private prison contractors;
21 and

22 ~~(8)~~ 8. To provide training to employees of private prison
23 contractors and other governmental entities on a fee basis;

1 9. To be notified of the annual budget work program of the
2 Department; and

3 10. To be notified of the deaths of inmates in the custody of
4 the Department.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
