PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S. 2021, Section 5-102, which relates to tagging of wildlife; exempting tag fee for tags for certain animals; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2021, Section 5-102, is amended to read as follows:

Section 5-102. A. No person may remove any propagated or released wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport which are killed at a commercial hunting area, including exotic wildlife, without attaching a tag to each of such killed wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport.

B. The tags shall be supplied by the Commission at a cost of no more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00); provided, that there shall be no fee for tags for females of the Cervidae family, feral swine, exotic

1 wildlife not native to North America, which are hunted for sport and
2 killed at a commercial hunting area. The tags shall contain such
3 information as the Commission may require and shall be numbered
4 consecutively.

5 C. Such tag must remain attached to the individual wildlife or
6 domesticated animals hunted for sport until prepared and consumed
7 and shall not be used more than once.

8 D. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
9 section shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred
10 Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
11 by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed sixty (60) days, or
12 by both such fine and imprisonment.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
