9 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S.  
11 2021, Section 5-102, which relates to tagging of  
12 wildlife; exempting tag fee for tags for certain  
13 animals; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2021, Section 5-102, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 5-102. A. No person may remove any propagated or  
18 released wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport which are  
19 killed at a commercial hunting area, including exotic wildlife,  
20 without attaching a tag to each of such killed wildlife or  
21 domesticated animals hunted for sport.

22 B. The tags shall be supplied by the Oklahoma Wildlife  
23 Conservation Commission at a cost of no more than Ten Dollars  
24 (\$10.00); provided, that there shall be no fee for tags for females

1 of the Cervidae family, feral swine, and exotic wildlife not native  
2 to North America, which are hunted for sport and killed at a  
3 commercial hunting area. The tags shall contain such information as  
4 the Commission may require and shall be numbered consecutively.

5 C. Such tag must remain attached to the individual wildlife or  
6 domesticated animals hunted for sport until prepared and consumed  
7 and shall not be used more than once.

8 D. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this  
9 section shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred  
10 Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or  
11 by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed sixty (60) days, or  
12 by both such fine and imprisonment.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
