8 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to public health and safety;  
10 establishing the requirements the platform is  
11 required to have; creating the Oklahoma Statewide  
12 Health Platform Revolving Fund; stating the purpose;  
13 providing for codification; providing an effective  
14 date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-103.1 of Title 63, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The Oklahoma Statewide Health Platform Revolving Fund in Section  
20 2 of this act shall be used exclusively to contract for and  
21 implement a statewide, enterprise-wide, cloud-based communication,  
22 and care coordination Health Insurance Portability and  
23 Accountability Act (HIPAA)-compliant platform that:

1       1. Provides every licensed hospital, Emergency Management  
2       Services (EMS) agency, and public health entity in the State of  
3       Oklahoma with real-time, HIPAA-compliant team alerting, live video  
4       consultation, electrocardiogram (ECG) and image sharing, patient  
5       channeling, and mass casualty and multiple casualty incident  
6       management for time-sensitive emergencies including stroke, ST-  
7       elevation myocardial infarction (STEMI), trauma, sepsis, cardiac  
8       arrest, respiratory failure, pediatric emergencies, other general  
9       emergencies, and natural disasters; and

10       2. Creates one unified operating platform connecting all  
11       emergency response entities across the entire state.

12       SECTION 2.        NEW LAW        A new section of law to be codified  
13       in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-103.2 of Title 63, unless  
14       there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15       There is hereby created in the State Treasury, a revolving fund  
16       for the Oklahoma State Department of Health to be designated the  
17       "Oklahoma Statewide Health Platform Revolving Fund". The fund shall  
18       be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and  
19       shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma State  
20       Department of Health from state-appropriated funds, federal funds,  
21       donations, grants, and contributions from any public or private  
22       source and designated for the purpose set forth in this section.  
23       All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby  
24       appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma State

1 Department of Health for the purpose provided for in Section 1 of  
2 this act. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants  
3 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
4 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
5 Services for approval and payment.

6 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

7 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
