9 An Act relating to the Pardon and Parole Board;  
10 amending 57 O.S. 2021, Section 332.1B, which relates  
11 to qualifications of Pardon and Parole Board members;  
12 specifying qualifications for members of the Pardon  
13 and Parole Board; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2021, Section 332.1B, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 332.1B. A. ~~To be eligible for appointment as a Pardon~~  
18 ~~and Parole Board member, a~~ As provided in Section 10, Article VI of  
19 the Oklahoma Constitution, the Governor shall appoint three of the  
20 five members of the Pardon and Parole Board, the Chief Justice of  
21 the Supreme Court shall appoint one member, and the presiding judge  
22 of the Criminal Court of Appeals shall appoint one member. In  
23 addition to the requirements provided for in subsections B, C, and D  
24 of this section, each person appointed shall possess a bachelor's

1 degree from an accredited college or university ~~and have at least~~  
2 ~~five (5) years of experience in one or more of the following fields:~~

3 ~~1. Criminal justice;~~

4 ~~2. Parole;~~

5 ~~3. Probation;~~

6 ~~4. Corrections;~~

7 ~~5. Criminal law;~~

8 ~~8. Law enforcement;~~

9 ~~7. 9. Mental health services;~~

10 ~~8. 10. Substance abuse services; or~~

11 ~~9. 11. Social work.~~

12 B. ~~At least two members of the Pardon and Parole Board~~ 1. One  
13 member appointed by the Governor shall have a minimum of five (5)  
14 years of ~~training or~~ experience in mental health services, ~~substance~~  
15 ~~abuse services or social work.~~

16 2. One member appointed by the Governor shall have a minimum of  
17 five (5) years of experience as a former correctional officer; and

18 3. One member appointed by the Governor shall have a minimum of  
19 five (5) years of experience as a former district attorney or  
20 assistant district attorney.

21 C. One member appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme  
22 Court shall be a former district court judge with a minimum of five  
23 (5) years of experience presiding over a criminal court docket.

1        D. One member appointed by the presiding judge of the Criminal  
2 Court of Appeals shall have a minimum of five (5) years of  
3 experience as a criminal defense attorney.

4        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
