PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to Department of Environmental  
Quality; creating the Biosolids Land Application  
Research Revolving Fund; stating type of fund;  
stating purpose of fund; providing for expenditures;  
providing for codification; providing an effective  
date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-10-205.2 of Title 27A, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
for the Department of Environmental Quality to be designated the  
"Biosolids Land Application Research Revolving Fund". The fund  
shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,  
and shall consist of all monies received by the Department of  
Environmental Quality as provided by law. All monies accruing to

1 the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted  
2 and expended by the Department of Environmental Quality for the  
3 purpose of obtaining equipment, staffing, and training for the  
4 testing of biosolids. Expenditures from said fund shall be made  
5 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as  
6 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and  
7 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
