9 An Act relating to smoking; creating the Oklahoma  
10 Clean Indoor Air Act; defining terms; prohibiting  
11 smoking in certain places; providing exceptions;  
12 mandating signage; providing for promulgation of  
13 rules from the State Department of Health; repealing  
14 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-1527, which relates to  
15 preemption; providing for noncodification; providing  
16 for codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Clean  
20 Indoor Air Act".

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1527.10 of Title 63, unless  
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. As used in this section:

1 1. "Cigar bar" means an establishment that exclusively occupies  
2 an enclosed indoor space and is primarily engaged in the retail sale  
3 of tobacco products for consumption by customers on the premises;

4 2. "Enclosed area" means a space with a roof and more than two  
5 walls;

6 3. "Public place" means any enclosed area to which the public  
7 is invited or permitted;

8 4. "Smoking" means cigarettes, cigars, pipes, and electronic  
9 smoking devices, including but not limited to vapes; and

10 5. "Workplace" means any indoor area under the control of an  
11 employer where employees perform duties.

12 B. Smoking shall be prohibited in all the following places:

13 1. Indoor workplaces, including but not limited to, offices and  
14 factories;

15 2. Government buildings;

16 3. Restaurants and bars;

17 4. Public transportation;

18 5. Health care facilities;

19 6. Educational institutions;

20 7. Retail stores and malls; and

21 8. Sports arenas and stadiums.

22 C. Smoking shall be allowed:

23 1. In tobacco shops or cigar bars, with proper ventilation and  
24 signage;

1        2. Private residences, unless used for childcare or health care  
2 services;

3        3. Designated smoking rooms in hotels, with a limited  
4 percentage of rooms; and

5        4. On tribal lands and reservations.

6        D. Establishments shall have clear signage stating "No smoking"  
7 at entrances and throughout facilities.

8        E. The State Department of Health shall promulgate rules to  
9 enforce the provisions of this act.

10       F. Local governments or municipalities may enact stricter  
11 ordinances.

12       SECTION 3.        REPEALER        63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-1527, is  
13 hereby repealed.

14       SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
