9 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to contracts; creating the Oklahoma
11 Homeowner Repair Contract Protection Act; defining
12 home solicitation contract; allowing a five-day
13 voidable contract period for homeowners; providing
14 for codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1100 of Title 15, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 This act shall be known as the "Oklahoma Homeowner Repair
20 Contract Protection Act".

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1101 of Title 15, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 "Home solicitation contract" means entering into a home repair
25 contract or services in which the home repair contractor or a person

1 acting for him or her engages in a personal solicitation of the sale
2 at a residence of the buyer, and the buyer's agreement is given to
3 the contractor or a person acting for him or her. It does not
4 include a sale made pursuant to a preexisting revolving contract, or
5 a contract made pursuant to prior negotiations between the parties
6 at a business establishment at a fixed location where goods or
7 services are offered or exhibited for sale. Nothing in this act
8 shall prohibit advertising, responding to homeowner-initiated
9 contact, or performing services when contacted directly by the
10 property owner.

11 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1102 of Title 15, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 1. In addition to any right otherwise to revoke an offer, the
15 homeowner has the right to cancel a home solicitation contract until
16 midnight of the fifth calendar day after the day on which the
17 homeowner signs an agreement for home repairs;

18 2. Cancellation occurs when the homeowner gives written notice
19 of cancellation via certified mail to the contractor at the address
20 stated in the agreement or offer to purchase;

21 3. Notice of cancellation is given when it is deposited in a
22 mailbox properly addressed and postage prepaid; and

23 4. Notice of cancellation given by the homeowner need not take
24 a particular form and is sufficient if it indicates by any form of

1 written expression the intention of the homeowner not to be bound by
2 the home solicitation sale.

3 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.

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
