8 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to ivermectin; defining term;  
10 allowing ivermectin to be sold or purchased without  
11 prescription; providing for immunity; providing for  
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13  
14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 355.5 of Title 59, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. As used in this section, "over-the-counter medication" means  
19 medication that may be legally sold and purchased without  
20 prescription.

21 B. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, ivermectin suitable  
22 for human use may be sold or purchased as an over-the-counter  
23 medication in this state without a prescription or consultation with  
24 a health care professional.

1 C. Notwithstanding any other law, a pharmacy is not criminally  
2 or civilly liable for supplying ivermectin in accordance with this  
3 section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
