9 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to economic development incentives;
11 making appropriation to the Office of the Governor;
12 stating amount and purpose; creating the Oklahoma
13 Special Events Trust Fund; providing for revenue
sources; specifying purposes; providing for
implementation of the Oklahoma Quality Events
Incentive Act; prescribing method for expenditures;
providing for codification; providing an effective
date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the from any monies
17 not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the
18 State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, the sum of
19 Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
20 necessary to effectively implement the Oklahoma Quality Events
21 Incentive Act by making payments in order to obtain contractual
22 commitments for eligible events.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4312 of Title 68, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
5 for the Office of the Governor to be designated the "Oklahoma
6 Special Events Trust Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund,
7 not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all
8 monies received by the Office of the Governor from such sources as
9 may be provided by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said
10 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
11 Office of the Governor for the purpose of fully implementing the
12 provisions of the Oklahoma Quality Events Incentive Act.

13 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
14 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
15 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
16 approval and payment.

17 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

18 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
