8 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
10 2021, Section 5401, which relates to the Oklahoma  
11 Strategic Military Planning Commission; re-creating  
the Commission; providing a date of dissolution; and  
declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 5401, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 5401. A. There is hereby re-created the Oklahoma  
18 Strategic Military Planning Commission.

19 B. The Oklahoma Strategic Military Planning Commission shall  
20 consist of nine (9) members as follows:

21 1. Five persons to be appointed by the Governor, each of whom  
22 shall represent, respectively, the interests of communities that  
23 would be affected by realignment or closure of the following  
24 military installations:

1                   a. Altus Air Force Base,  
2                   b. Vance Air Force Base,  
3                   c. Fort Sill,  
4                   d. the Army Ammunition Plant located near McAlester, and  
5                   e. Tinker Air Force Base;

6                   2. One person to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
7                   Representatives from the membership of the House and one person to  
8                   be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate from the  
9                   membership of the Senate. The members appointed pursuant to this  
10                  paragraph shall be ex officio and nonvoting members of the  
11                  Commission; and

12                  3. The Secretary of Veterans Affairs, or successor member of  
13                  the Governor's Executive Cabinet who has responsibility for Veterans  
14                  Affairs, and the Adjutant General of the Oklahoma Army and Air  
15                  National Guard. The members appointed pursuant to this paragraph  
16                  shall be ex officio and nonvoting members of the Commission.

17                  C. The members of the Commission shall serve at the pleasure of  
18                  the appointing authority. The members of the Commission shall  
19                  select from among their membership a chair and vice-chair. The  
20                  chair and vice-chair shall serve for a period of one (1) year and  
21                  may succeed themselves in office.

22                  D. The Commission shall be subject to the provisions of the  
23                  Oklahoma Open Meeting Act and the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

1       E. The Commission shall be authorized to meet at such times as  
2 may be required in order to fulfill the duties and responsibilities  
3 imposed upon it by law.

4       F. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force  
5 and effect of law and the Commission shall be dissolved by operation  
6 of law on December 31, 2025 2030.

7       G. The members of the Commission shall not be deemed to be  
8 officers or to hold public office for purposes of Section 6 of Title  
9 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10      SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
