PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to State Question 780 data; amending 57 O.S. 2021, Section 632, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 201, O.S.L. 2023, and as renumbered by Section 6, Chapter 201, O.S.L. 2023 (43A O.S. Supp. 2025, Section 2-312.2), which relates to calculation of savings and averted costs from implementation of the Oklahoma Smart Justice Reform Act; requiring the Department of Corrections to provide certain data to the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency; requiring the Administrator of the Courts to provide certain data to the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2021, Section 632, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 201, O.S.L. 2023, and as renumbered by Section 6, Chapter 201, O.S.L. 2023 (43A O.S. Supp. 2025, Section 2-312.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-312.2. No later than July 31 of each year, the Department of Corrections shall provide the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency with data for the prior fiscal year ending June

1 30, reflecting the number of unique offenders and days served by  
2 each offender, upon completion of the corresponding sentence, for  
3 those convicted only of crimes modified by State Question 780. No  
4 later than July 31 of each year, the Administrator of the Courts  
5 shall provide the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency with  
6 data necessary to calculate the annual savings and averted costs,  
7 including the number of persons convicted only of crimes modified by  
8 State Question 780 and the number of days sentenced for such crimes.  
9 For purposes of this section, crimes modified by State Question 780  
10 shall include only those crimes that were previously felonies that  
11 are now misdemeanors and crimes that fall between the former dollar  
12 threshold and current dollar threshold for crimes whose severity is  
13 determined by a dollar threshold. No later than thirty (30) days  
14 after being provided with the data from both the Department of  
15 Corrections and the Administrator of the Courts, the Legislative  
16 Office of Fiscal Transparency shall calculate the annual savings and  
17 averted costs from the prior fiscal year that accrued to the state  
18 due to the reduction of the number and length of incarcerations  
19 attributed to the implementation of the Oklahoma Smart Justice  
20 Reform Act. In making the calculation required by this section, the  
21 Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency shall use actual data or  
22 best available estimates where actual data is not available. The  
23 calculation shall be final and shall not be adjusted for any  
24 subsequent changes in the underlying data.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
