8 PROPOSED OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to the State Capitol Preservation  
10 Commission; authorizing the placement of a monument  
11 near the State Capitol Arch; directing the State  
12 Capitol Commission to work with private entities to  
13 erect the monument; providing for codification; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4110.2 of Title 74, unless there  
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The State Capitol Preservation Commission or designee is hereby  
20 authorized to permit and arrange for the placement of the Gold Star  
21 Family Monument. This monument shall be designed, constructed, and  
22 placed on the Capitol Grounds by private entities at no expense to  
23 the State of Oklahoma. The State Capitol Preservation Commission or  
24 designee is authorized to assist private entities in placing the

1 monument in the northwest corner behind the State Capitol Arch for  
2 the monument and arranging a suitable time for its placement.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
