9 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to the State Capitol Preservation  
11 Commission; authorizing the placement of a monument  
12 near the State Capitol Arch; directing the State  
13 Capitol Commission to work with private entities to  
14 erect the monument; providing for codification; and  
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4110.2 of Title 74, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The State Capitol Preservation Commission or designee is hereby  
21 authorized to permit and arrange for the placement of the Gold Star  
22 Family Monument. This monument shall be designed, constructed, and  
23 placed on the Capitol Grounds by private entities at no expense to  
24 the State of Oklahoma. The State Capitol Preservation Commission or  
designee is authorized to assist private entities in placing the

1      monument in the northwest corner behind the State Capitol Arch for  
2      the monument and arranging a suitable time for its placement.

3      SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
